Addendum #2 – July 16, 2026

1. What is the extent of wetlands delineation required at this stage in the design?

At this stage, we need to delineate areas that potentially need a wetland permit. A wetland delineation is needed when impacts proposed to wetlands and buffers are not restoration practices. The delineation should include a 50 to 100-foot buffer from the potential Limit of Disturbance (LOD). Areas/activities that potentially need a permit are: installation of hard infrastructure riprap/armoring; temporary staging/storage areas and access roads; cutting of woody vegetation; areas of sediment disposal. This wetland delineation needs to occur prior to a planned drawdown.
